What does it mean to be a Sponsoring Stake of Brighton Girls Camp?

- Guaranteed reservation space for the young women in your stake who are 12 turning 13.
- Participation in our early registration process. A representative of the Stake YW leadership attends a training meeting in February and works with Brighton Girls Camp to register the campers in your stake.
- Reduced registration fee per camper (**Fees = \$230 vs. \$255 for public.**)
- An annual stake assessment fee (currently \$400 due in early February each year.)
- Opportunities for meaningful service. Sponsoring stakes provide 8-10 women and 8-10 men as scheduled every 2 ½ years to assist with the opening or closing (winterizing) of camp.

Benefits of Brighton for stakes:

- An annual event for your young women to look forward to each summer
- Opportunities for service projects for your stake young men and young women
- Great employment opportunity for 16 to 17-year-old YW in the kitchen
- Meaningful employment opportunities for young single adult women ages 18 to 25
- Brighton has service opportunities for senior missionary couples
